Camp Scholarship Application Procedures

Dear Applicant:

To insure fairness in processing and issuing a limited number of camperships each year, Camp DaKaNi follows this guideline:

Camp scholarships will be issued on a first come first serve basis. Awards will be made based on the financial need of the child and the availability of funds. Camp scholarships are awarded on a sliding scale until funds are depleted.

To be eligible for a scholarship, you must submit all of the following documents:

1. Proof of guardianship- copy of birth certificate or court documents
2. Proof of total annual household income (see Verification Requirements on the next page)
3. Signed camp scholarship application (this document, signed)

You will be notified of the scholarship award via phone and/or email.

How to apply for a Camp Scholarship:

1. Complete the attached application
2. Attach all required documents listed above.

Exclusions and Exceptions:

1. Fee reductions will apply only to the program registration fees for eligible applicants meeting all requirements at the time of registration.
2. No child will receive assistance for more than one camp session per summer. (Unless reviewed and approved by Camp Director)
3. In order to serve as many youth as possible, Camp DaKaNi will give each applicant a scholarship for no more than two consecutive years.

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Low Income Fee Support Guidelines Camp Scholarship

Camp DaKaNi has established guidelines to determine if campership applicants qualify for a reduction in fees for programs. *Applicants must provide proof of eligibility for all conditions, as noted in verification requirement, at the time of registration.*

Eligibility requirements:

Applicant is low income based on the Federal Poverty Guidelines*. Applicants family income does not exceed 100% of the federal poverty level (established yearly by the U.S. government based on family size and income) will be given first priority. Applicants whose income exceeds 100% of the federal poverty level will be considered on the following sliding scale:

Income Range	Maximum Scholarship Allocation
0-100% of Federal Poverty Level (FPL)	75% of camp fee
101-137% above FPL	60% of camp fee
138-150% above FPL	50% of camp fee
151-200% above FPL	40% of camp fee
201-250% above FPL	30% of camp fee

* Federal Poverty Level Chart attached at end of document.

Other applicants will be considered based on financial need and/or extenuating circumstances (including families with children in foster care). Allocation applies after all applicable discounts and credits.

Verification Requirements:

1. Parent/Legal Guardian - (one of the following)
 - a. Parent: Birth certificate showing relationship to participants under 18. or
 - b. Legal Guardian: Court document stipulating guardianship, custody, or other form of appointment.
2. Proof of total annual household income– (one of the following)
 - a. Federal W-2 or
 - b. Public Assistance check or
 - c. Documentation from Social Service Agency that has verified income. or
 - d. Page 1 of previous years Federal Tax Form 1040.
